



Carpet Spotting Guide



Overall: If using only one spotter, choose P&G Pro Line General Use Carpet Spot Remover

Unidentifiable Stains: Product order for attempted stain removal is:

General Use Spot Remover → Bio Spot Remover → Tannin Spot Remover

Spot Removal – Do not spray spot cleaners; Wear Suitable Protective Clothing

- Apply a small amount of spotter to spot.
- Agitate spot with blunt end of spotting brush from outside edge in.
- Blot with clean white damp cloth after each step.
- As a final step, apply a light water rinse and blot dry.
- Allow to dry then vacuum clean.

TYPICAL STAINS	SPOTTERS	SPOTTING PROCEDURES
Asphalt, Cosmetics, Crayon, Grease, Iodine, Ink, Oil Stains, Shoe Polish, Tar, & Wax	P&G Pro Line General Use Carpet Spot Remover	After stain is removed, blot with clean white damp cloth. Extract, if desired. For difficult stains, repeat application may be required.
Beer, Berry Stains, and Mustard	P&G Pro Line Bio Spot Carpet Spot Remover	
Coffee, Cola and Tea	P&G Pro Line Tannin Spot Carpet Spot Remover	
Catsup, Chocolate, Food Stains, Grass, Gravies, and Meat	P&G Pro Line Bio Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Stop when stain is removed. Extract if desired.
Urine and Fecal Matter	P&G Pro Line Bio Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Stop when stain is removed. Deodorize or extract, if desired.
Cherry Coke, Kool Aid, Red Wine (Any food containing #20 RED DYE)	P&G Pro Line General Use Carpet Spot Remover	Apply liberally to stain. Cover stain with moist clean white towel. Preheat iron to cotton setting. Apply iron in 4-5 second intervals, moving towel to clean area each time. Repeat until stain is lifted. DO NOT SCRUB AREA: BLOT ONLY. Be careful to avoid overheating carpet.
Blood	P&G Pro Line Bio Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Stop when stain is removed. Extract, if desired.
Brownout, Soap or Shampoo Residue Buildup	P&G Pro Line Tannin Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Pre-treat with product listed. Allow to air dry.
Water Rings	P&G Pro Line Tannin Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Stop when stain is removed. Extract, if desired.
Perfume	P&G Pro Line General Use Carpet Spot Remover	Stop when stain is removed. Deodorize or extract, if desired.
Rust	P&G Pro Line Tannin Spot Carpet Spot Remover	Apply to rust spot and blot dry. Extract, if desired.
Chewing Gum	P & G Pro-Line Chewing Gum Remover	Apply to gum, break or chip from surface.
